How to create a composer package in private gitlab repository.

Requirements

• **URL**: https://git.pegotec.pro

• **Domain**: git.pegotec.pro

• **Deploy Token Username**: pegotec-bucket

• Deploy Token: ************

• Group ID: 27

Package

o Package Name: pegotec/bucket

Project ID: 100 Version:1.0.1

Installation and implementations

Create a new package with composer.json

Published Package using API using Deploy Token

Command

curl --data tag=<version> --header "Deploy-Token:<deploy_token>"
"<URL>/api/v4/projects//project_id>/packages/composer"

Example

curl --data tag=1.0.1 --header "Deploy-Token:zpkJVxEzCHTbDN3SgBja" "https://git.pegotec.pro/api/v4/projects/100/packages/composer"

Result in repository > Package and Registry (exits in sidebar menu)



Install a Composer package

- **1.** Add the Package Registry URL to your project's **composer.json** file, along with the package name and version to install:
 - Command
 composer config repositories.<group_id> composer <URL>/api/v4/group/<group_id>//packages/composer/
 - Example
 composer config repositories.27 composer https://git.pegotec.pro/api/v4/group/27//packages/composer/
 - Result in composer.json file

```
"repositories": [{
    "type": "composer",
    "url": "https://qit.peqotec.pro/api/v4/qroup/27/-/packaqes/composer/"
}]
```

- 2. Create an auth.json file with your GitLab credentials:
 - Command composer config gitlab-token.git.<domain> <deploy_token_username> <deploy_token>
 - Example
 composer config gitlab-token.git.git.pegotec.pro pegotec-bucket
 zpkJVxEzCHTbDN3SgBja
 - Result in auth.json

- 3. With the composer.json and auth.json files configured, we can install the package by running:
 - Command composer require <package_name>:<version>
 - Example composer require pegotec/bucket:1.0.1
 - Result in composer.json
